

BHUA Privacy policy

About this site

1. Data Protection and privacy

- 1.1 "BHUA" shall mean Buckinghamshire Hockey Umpires Association and any future name by which this association may be known.
- 1.2 This privacy policy applies to any information acquired by and/or provided to BHUA including but not limited to:
 1. information acquired/provided through use of the following websites: the BHUA website at www.buckshua.co.uk, the Buckinghamshire Hockey Association website at www.buckshockey.co.uk and the Southern Counties Hockey Umpires Association website at www.schua.co.uk ("the websites");
 2. information acquired/provided during the course of any transaction;
 3. information acquired/provided through enquiries or by the completion of any request and or invitation for information;
 4. information acquired/provided through awards;
 5. information acquired/provided through any other source which we obtain in relation to you.
- 1.3 BHUA recognises that your privacy is important to you. The information you submit to BHUA will be kept confidential and secure once received. The information will be processed by BHUA or on its behalf under strictly regulated conditions in accordance with the provisions of the Data Protection Act 1998.

2. How we use your personal information

- 2.1. Any personal information provided by you to or obtained from other sources by BHUA will only be used for the following purposes:
 1. updating and enhancing contact and membership records;
 2. compiling information relating to your use of BHUA services and defining areas of interest to you;
 3. improving the Websites to meet users' habits and requirements and compiling information relating to users' movements across the Website ;
 4. providing umpiring services to the clubs and organisations that we serve;
 5. responding to queries from the clubs and organisations that we serve.

3. Disclosure

- 3.1 BHUA will only disclose this information in the following circumstances:
 1. where your consent has been obtained;
 2. where there is a legal obligation.

4 Accuracy

- 4.1 BHUA will take reasonable steps to create an accurate record of any personal data you have submitted. However, BHUA does not assume responsibility for confirming the ongoing accuracy of your personal data. You can update your personal data by making amendments in the "Personal Area" section of the website.
- 4.2 BHUA is exempt from registration with the Information Commissioner's Office, but, nevertheless, takes seriously its responsibilities for protecting personal data. Any question relating to data protection, including data security should be referred to the Secretary in the first instance.

5. Policy Modification

Any modifications to the privacy practices of BHUA will be reflected first within this area of our website. If there is a material change in our privacy practices, BHUA will indicate on this site that BHUA's privacy practices have changed, and make the necessary amendments to the current privacy policy. If BHUA considers using the information collected from you in a manner materially different from that stated at the time of collection, BHUA will send written notice by email of the change to all current members.
